The Scoop:

- Open to all students in Kindergarten through 5th grade.
- Drawing must illustrate a fire safety theme.
- Team artists or individual artists are allowed on each drawing.
- Please include student's first name, grade, school and teacher's name.

Drawing Theme Ideas:

Check your smoke alarms	Check your carbon monoxide detectors
Never leave the kitchen when cooking	Fire sprinklers save lives
Cool a burn	Never leave a burning candle unattended
Have a family meeting place	Stop, Drop and Roll
Practice your family escape plan	If a smoke alarm sounds, get out and stay out!
Crawl low under smoke	Fire is a tool, not a toy
