

SMC Alert Overview



San Mateo County's primary emergency notification system for life safety, fire, weather, accidents, and disasters.



Opt-In Subscription

Free subscription for personalized emergency alerts, including warnings and recovery information.

Managed by San Mateo County Emergency Management (SMCEM)

This Service available countywide, to all cities, towns and special districts. Alerts may also be sent by local police, fire and emergency managers from other cities within San Mateo County.

SMC Alert Overview



To ensure you receive alerts select to receive all three methods:

Text



 Sends emergency and nonemergency text message alerts to opt-in <u>cellular</u> <u>devices</u> within a targeted area

Email



 Sends emergency and nonemergency email alerts to opt-in email addresses within a targeted area

Voice ullim

 Sends emergency and nonemergency email alerts to opt-in cellular AND landline accounts within a targeted area


Share my Profile with San Mateo County CA to support emergency preparedness.

Your profile can deliver valuable information to 9-1-1 and first responders, such as medical conditions, address details, and emergency contacts. This information can save valuable time during an emergency.




SMC Alert Overview



SMC Alert (Mass Notification System Opt-In)

When you register, it's important to add addresses such as your home, work or child's school. When you enter an address, the address is geocoded within the mapping system. This mapping system allows emergency managers to focus their alerts down to a specific neighborhood or an entire city or region. If you don't include at least one address, you may miss an important alert or receive alerts from other parts of the county.







Police and Fire Vehicle Sirens and Public Address Systems

County-wide, local police and fire agencies will use their vehicle-mounted sirens and public address loudspeaker systems to notify neighborhoods of evacuation orders or other urgent information. This method may be the oldest but is one of the more effective methods for alerting and informing specific, localized areas of evacuation orders and other required emergency actions.



- **EVACUATION ORDER:** You must evacuate immediately due to imminent threat to life.
- **EVACUATION WARNING:** There is potential threat to life and property within a given time frame. Begin preparing yourself, your animals, and your property for a potential evacuation order.
- **SHELTER-IN-PLACE:** Stay secure at your current location. This may be required when evacuation is impossible, too dangerous, or unnecessary.



Types of Alerts

Integrated Public Alert & Warning System (IPAWS)



IPAWS

The Integrated Public Alert & Warning System (IPAWS) is FEMA's national system for local alerting that provides authenticated emergency and life-saving information to the public through cell phones using Wireless Emergency
Alerts, to radio and television via the Emergency Alert System, and on the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's Weather
Radio.





Integrated Public Alert and Warning System (IPAWS)

*Automatically opted-in to IPAWS

Wireless Emergency Alert (WEA)

 Sends emergency alerts to <u>all mobile</u> <u>devices</u> within a targeted area





Emergency Alert System (EAS)

 Sends emergency messages <u>via TV</u>, <u>radio</u>, and satellite





Non-Weather Emergency Message (NWEM)

Sends non-weather emergency alerts via the National Weather Service (NWS) through NOAA Weather Radio





What Do the Alerts Look Like? WEA will look like a text message. The WEA message will typically show the type and time of the alert, any action you should take, and the government agency issuing the alert. WEA messages include a special tone and vibration, both repeated twice.

What Kind of Alerts?

WEA are sent only during an emergency. They are sent by government alerting authorities through your mobile carrier.


Types of alerts include:

- Extreme weather warnings
- Local emergencies requiring evacuation or immediate action
- AMBER Alerts
- · Presidential Alerts during a national emergency

The National Weather Services sends WEA messages for:

- Dust Storm Warnings
- Extreme Wind Warnings
- Flash Flood Warnings*
- Hurricane/Typhoon Warnings
- Severe Thunderstorm Warnings*
- Snow Squall Warnings
- Storm Surge Warnings
- Tornado Warnings
- Tsunami Warnings

* High-damage threat Warnings only

WARNING

A warning is issued when a hazardous weather or hydrologic event is occurring, imminent or likely. A warning means weather conditions pose a threat to life or property. People in the path of the storm need to take protective action.

ADVISORY

An advisory is issued when a hazardous weather or hydrologic event is occurring, imminent or likely. Advisories are for less serious conditions than warnings, that cause significant inconvenience and if caution is not exercised, could lead to situations that may threaten life or property.

WATCH

A watch is used when the risk of a hazardous weather or hydrologic event has increased significantly, but its occurrence, location or timing is still uncertain. It is intended to provide enough lead time so those who need to set their plans in motion can do so. A watch means that hazardous weather is possible. People should have a plan of action in case a storm threatens and they should listen for later information and possible warnings especially when planning travel or outdoor activities.






